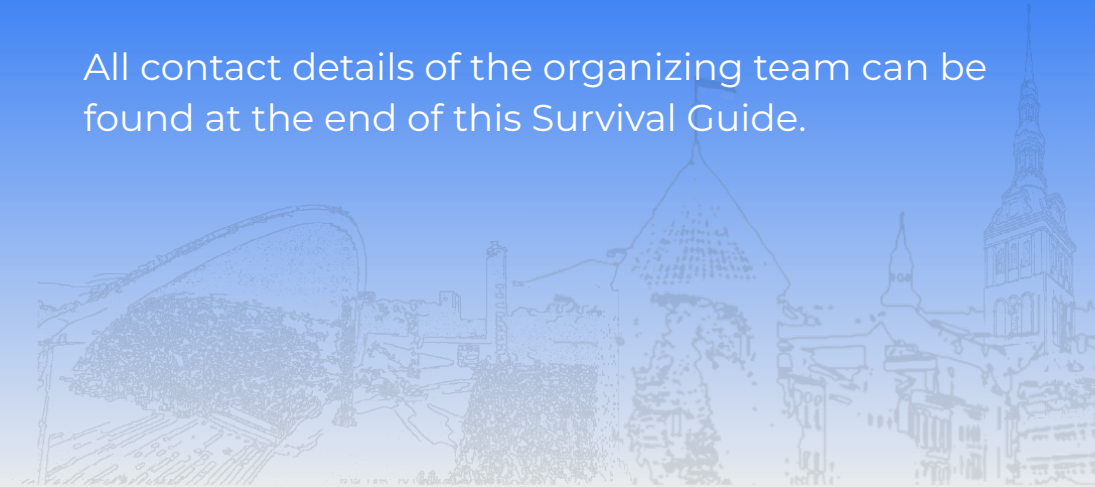


Accommodation

What to bring?

- ID or passport & European medical insurance card
- Warm clothes - weather can be cold and rainy (outdoor activity on Saturday). Forecast 15-18 °C day time and 8-12°C night time.

Transport in Tallinn

- Most of the event logistics will take place using public transport or hosts' cars.
- The organizing team will provide participants with QR tickets that can be used in Tallinn public transport during the entire stay, so there is no need to purchase additional tickets.
 - o QR ticket must be validated at the bottom of the rectangular orange validator located at the front door of the public transport vehicle: place the QR code displayed on a smart device screen or printed on paper in front of the code reader screen situated at the lower part of the rectangular validator.
- Public transport in Tallinn includes buses, trams, and trolleybuses. Use Google Maps for navigating the public transport.
- For nighttime taxi rides, we recommend using Uber or Bolt instead of traditional taxi companies.

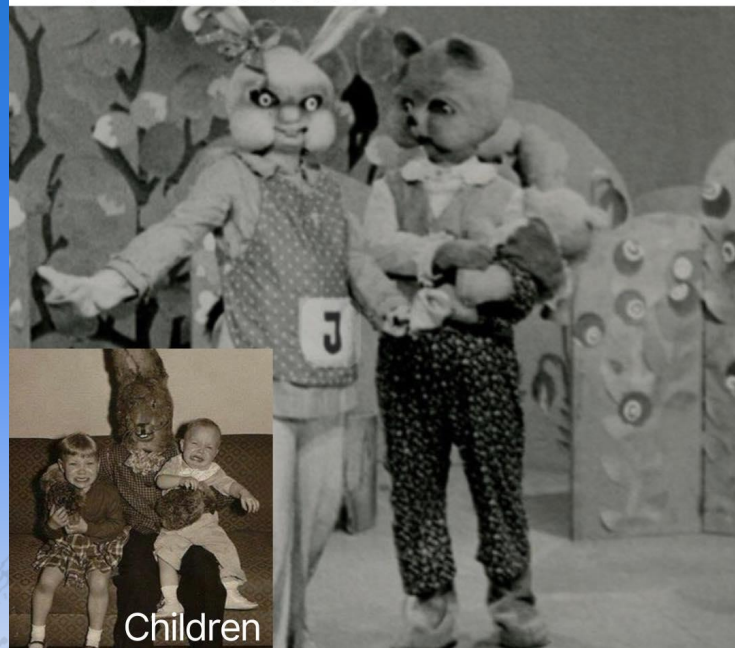

Fun facts about Estonia

- Over 2200 islands, 1000 lakes, and 7000 rivers.
- Estonia has won Eurovision once (2001).
- Estonia is a Singing Nation - every five years there is The Song Festival, where about 1/5 of the entire population sing our folk songs.
- Estonia holds the largest collection of national folk songs in the world, which is over 13 300 songs.
- Estonia has the most startups per capita in Europe - we have produced for example Skype, Wise and Bolt.
- Estonia is flat like a pancake - the highest point (Suur Munamägi aka Big Egg Hill) is only 318 meters high, which is the highest in the Baltic region.
